## Required Vendor Licensing

If you did not supply these permit numbers on your registration form, please email your required current license numbers to info@scglitz.com:

**NP Non-Profit Organizations:**

✓ Please include your federal non-profit EIN# on your registration form

**RV Retail vendors conducting sales (when money is changing hands):**

✓ SC Business License (either annual or 1-day out-of-town)

**FV Food Vendors or Food Trucks**

✓ SC Business License (either annual or 1-day out-of-town)

✓ OC Health Department License (either TFF for booths, or MFF for trucks)

### RV RETAIL VENDORS CONDUCTING SALES

1. Traditional Annual SC Business License  
(for San Clemente-based businesses)

OR

2. Special 1-Day SC Business License - \$25  
(for out-of-town businesses only)

### FV FOOD & DRINK VENDORS (even pre-packaged food) OR FOOD TRUCKS

In addition to a San Clemente annual or 1-day out-of-town business license, vendors selling food or drinks (even pre-packaged food) must obtain a permit from the OC Health Department.

You must supply one of these two types of OC Health permits:

**TFF Permit required for food booths, also known as Temporary Food Facilities (TFF).** When no cooking or food prep is taking place. This is the only type of food booth permitted at a Glitz vendor space.

OR

**MFF Permit required for carts and trucks, also referred to as Mobil Food Facilities (MFF).** This is when food prep is taking place, only food trucks would be in this category at the Glitz.
